Established in 1987, Pacific Assistance Dogs Society has been breeding, raising, training and placing life-changing assistance dogs for over 35 years. The purpose of these amazing dogs is to provide their partners with an increased level of independence and an enhanced quality of life or to provide comfort or rehabilitative care for individuals working with community care professionals.

## **PROGRAM AREAS**



## **MOBILITY**SERVICE DOGS

Mobility Service dogs learn skills such as opening and closing doors, pushing elevator and crosswalk buttons, turning lights on and off and can even provide balance and stability to clients with mobility issues.



#### PTSD SERVICE DOGS

These caring dogs are trained to support First Responders and Military Veterans with Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD or Complex PTSD) by providing important physical, calming and grounding skills.



# **HEARING**DOGS

These special dogs are trained to alert their partners to a variety of sounds such as door knocks, doorbells, telephone rings, timers and smoke alarms....even a baby's cry or their name being called!



# **ACCREDITED**FACILITY DOGS

care professionals

be physical, social
or emotional

dogs work in justice,
education and
health/wellness
roles.



## **VERY IMPORTANT**PETS

Dogs that aren't suited for working in a public setting put their extensive training and socialization to work as the beloved pet of a child or adult with a disability.

#### **EXPANSION PROJECT**

The expansion of PADS Calgary is an important next step in the life of the organization. All aspects of PADS operations must grow - staff, volunteers, puppies and dogs, and training space. This will allow PADS to increase the number of accredited assistance dog placements in the region by 150% or more and help us to continue **Changing Lives** -

# LIFE OF A PADS DOG

Each of our graduate dogs has completed 16 months of extensive socialization as well as a minimum of 150 hours of professional training. This is done at PADS or on career specific field trips to ensure that they not only know their skills, but are comfortable using them anywhere!



#### **PUPPY PRESCHOOL**

FIRST TWO MONTHS

The pup is born and reared in the home of a volunteer Breeder-Caretaker.



#### **PUPPY ACADEMY**

14-16 MONTHS

At 8 weeks the pup is matched with a volunteer Puppy-Raiser to learn the basics.



#### **CANINE COLLEGE**

4-12 MONTHS

The young dogs learn the skills they will need for a life of service from our professional trainers.




Teams are supported monthly for the first year and then annually for recertification.
